FROZEN SEMEN CONTRACT

1. Booking Fee, Contract, and Registration Papers. A separate \$ \_\_\_\_\_ non-refundable booking fee must be paid to Suzanne C. Quarles at Some Day Soon Farm when mare owner returns this contract. A copy of the mare's registration papers must be submitted with the contract if the mare is to be included in any report of mares bred for Wertherson.

2. Documentation. When this contract is signed and returned, Some Day Soon Farm will send the mare owner a Mare Identification Form and a Mare Breeding Passport. The Mare Identification Form and the Mare Identification page of the Mare Breeding Passport must be filled out by the mare owner. The Mare Identification Form must be returned to Suzanne C. Quarles before delivery of the frozen semen. The Mare Breeding Passport must be filled out by the veterinarian on the day(s) of insemination and pregnancy checks and returned to Suzanne C. Quarles after the final pregnancy check or before September 1. The mare owner must return the frozen semen container within one week of receipt of the frozen semen.

3. Pre-shipment Steps. In addition to the signed contract and the booking fee (see section 1) and the Mare Identification Form (see section 2), Suzanne C. Quarles must receive the \$\_\_\_\_\_ deposit on the frozen semen container, and a current uterine culture (taken when the mare is in heat, and submitted to a licensed laboratory) before frozen semen will be shipped to the mare owner. The container deposit shall act as money on account for collection and transportation costs of the mare owner. When 2/3 of this amount has been spent, Some Day Soon Farm will require that the deposit be replenished.
4. Shipment. The shipment to the mare owner will contain six straws of frozen semen. If more than six straws is required, the mare owner will be charged \$\_\_\_\_\_, plus shipping, for each additional straw.
5. Mare-Specific. The frozen semen may be used only for the mare designated on this contract, unless permission for insemination of another mare is granted by, and additional booking and stud fees are paid to, Suzanne C. Quarles. Should the semen be used on a mare other than the mare so designated on this contract without such permission, this contract becomes null and void.
6. Live Foal Guarantee. It is agreed that a live foal (i.e., a newborn foal that stands and nurses) is guaranteed from the frozen semen for a maximum of three breeding seasons. If the foal is born dead, the mare owner may exercise return privileges for the following season, if Suzanne C. Quarles is notified within 72 hours from the foaling date, and receives a veterinarian's statement concerning the circumstances of death within 10 days of the foaling date. If the mare dies or, after examination by two licensed veterinarians, is found unfit to breed, another mare may be substituted with the consent of Suzanne C. Quarles. If the mare is examined by a licensed veterinarian and found to be barren 50 to 70 days from the last date of insemination, return privileges are also granted. If, after two full breeding seasons the mare does not conceive, the mare owner may substitute another mare with the consent of Suzanne C. Quarles.
7. Maintaining Guarantee. A licensed veterinarian must examine the mare 50 to 70 days after the last insemination date and advise Suzanne C. Quarles in writing of the mare's pregnancy status. If this notification is not provided, the live foal guarantee of this contract becomes null and void. This notification can be provided by returning the completed Mare Breeding Passport.
8. Semen Administration. Suzanne C. Quarles and Some Day Soon Farm assume responsibility only to deliver frozen semen in viable condition at the time of delivery to the mare owner or his or her designee. The semen must be administered by a licensed veterinarian; otherwise, all conditions of this contract become null and void.
9. Contract Execution. This contract is in duplicate. The mare owner must sign both copies and return them to Suzanne C. Quarles. When Ms. Quarles signs and returns one copy of this contract to the mare owner, it will then be a binding contract on both parties, subject to all above terms and conditions. This contract may not be assigned or transferred by the mare owner.
