1. Booking Fee. Contract. and Registration Papers. A separate, \$ \_\_\_\_\_ non-refundable booking fee must be paid to Suzanne C. Quarles at *Some Day Soon Farm* when the Mare Owner returns this contract. The booking fee includes up to two free shipments of live semen for the duration of the contract (*see* paragraph 4). A copy of the Mare's registration papers must be submitted with the contract if the Mare is to be included in any report of Mares bred for the Stallion.

2. Documentation. When this contract is signed and returned, *Some Day Soon Farm* will send the Mare Owner a Mare Identification Form and a Mare Breeding Passport. The Mare Identification Form and the Mare Identification portion of the Mare Breeding Passport must be filled out by the Mare Owner. The Mare Identification Form must be returned to Suzanne C. Quarles before semen delivery. *The Mare Owner should obtain a uterine culture before inseminating the Mare.* The Mare Breeding Passport must be filled out by the veterinarian on the day(s) of insemination, and pregnancy checks of the Mare and returned to Suzanne C. Quarles within 50 to 70 days of the last insemination date or by September 1, whichever comes first. (This is necessary to maintain the live foal guarantee. *See* paragraph 7.) A Delivery and Insemination Certificate For Transported Semen will be sent with each shipment of semen. The Certificate must be completed by the veterinarian on each day of insemination. Within 24 hours of receipt of the transported semen, the Mare Owner must return the semen container (Equitainer), with the completed Delivery and Insemination Certificate, by Federal Express or UPS — second day.

3. Pre-shipment Steps. In addition to the signed contract and the booking fee (*see* section 1) and the Mare

Identification Form (*see* paragraph 2), Suzanne C. Quarles must receive the \$ \_\_\_\_\_ deposit on the Equitainer before live semen will be shipped to the Mare Owner. The Equitainer deposit shall act as money on account for collection and transportation costs of the Mare Owner. When 2/3 of this amount has been spent, *Some Day Soon Farm* will require that the deposit be replenished.

4. Shipment. If more than two shipments of live semen are required, the Mare Owner will be charged \$ \_\_\_\_\_ for each collection after the second shipment.

5. Mare-Specific. The transported semen may be used only for the Mare designated on this contract, and all excess semen must be destroyed. Should the semen be used on a mare other than the Mare so designated on this contract without Suzanne C. Quarles' written permission, this contract becomes null and void.

6. Live Foal Guarantee. It is agreed that a live foal (*i.e.*, a newborn foal that stands and nurses) is guaranteed from the transported semen for a maximum of three consecutive breeding seasons, beginning with the breeding season in the year this contract is signed, whether or not the Mare Owner exercises this right each year. If the foal is born dead, or dies before it stands and nurses, the Mare Owner may substitute another mare by submitting a new Mare Identification Form and filling out the Mare Identification portion of a new Mare Breeding Passport. However, the new mare would have only that portion of the 3-year live foal guarantee period remaining from the time this contract was signed for the original Mare.

7. Maintaining Guarantee. A licensed veterinarian must examine the Mare and advise Suzanne C. Quarles in writing of the Mare's pregnancy status within 50 to 70 days after the last insemination date or by September 1, whichever comes first. If this notification is not provided, the live foal guarantee of this contract becomes null and void. This notification can be provided by returning the completed Mare Breeding Passport.

8. Semen Administration. Suzanne C. Quarles and *Some Day Soon Farm* assume responsibility only to deliver live semen in viable condition at the time of delivery to the Mare Owner or his or her designee. The semen must be administered by a licensed veterinarian on the day of delivery; otherwise, all conditions of this contract become null and void.

9. Frozen Semen Alternative. Should the above Stallion die, become unfit for service, or be sold, to fulfill this contract you will be shipped frozen semen of the Stallion, if available, or you may elect to use fresh cooled semen of any other *Some Day Soon Farm* stallion of your choice. You must fill out another contract to receive either the frozen semen or the fresh-cooled semen.

10. Contract Execution. This contract is in duplicate. The Mare Owner must sign both copies and return them to Suzanne C. Quarles. When Ms. Quarles signs and returns one copy of this contract to the Mare Owner, it will then be a binding contract on both parties, subject to all above terms and conditions. This contract may not be assigned or transferred by the Mare Owner.

11. Breeding Season. The breeding season is from March 15 to July 15.
